# ALDO TATANGELO ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

### SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION:

Aldo Tatangelo Endowed Scholarship is restricted to TAMIU graduate students in public administration in good academic standing who are planning to develop a career in public policy or government. Scholarship funding is made possible by the generosity of the Aldo Tatangelo Endowment Fund. The Aldo Tatangelo Endowed Scholarship was created to honor Laredo's reform mayor, who served from 1978 to 1990. Under his leadership, the city charter changed the form of government from a mayor-council (strong mayor) to a council-manager system. With a professional city manager as the executive authority overseeing daily operations, the city threw off the yoke of the "patron system." Scholarship awards are dependent upon available funds. Only complete submissions will be considered. Scholarship money will be used to cover the costs of tuition, books, and fees. Recipients will be referred as Tatangelo Scholars.

#### SCHOLARSHIP CRITERIA:

- Currently registered graduate student pursuing degree in TAMIU's Master of Public Administration program
- GPA of 3.3 or higher on a 4.0 scale
- Have earned 12 or more semester credit hours in TAMIU's Master of Public Administration program
- Residency in Webb County, Laredo, or Nuevo Laredo

- Personal Statement (double-spaced and no more than one-page in length) Explain how TAMIU's Master of Public Administration program will contribute to the achievement of your public service career goals.
- Two letters of Recommendation
