

Evaluation of International Transcripts for Graduate Admission Purposes

Texas A&M International University's Graduate School conducts internal evaluations of foreign transcripts to establish eligibility for graduate admission. Transcripts and certificates of graduation (where applicable) are evaluated in accordance with higher education standards and generally accepted industry practices. The results of our evaluation remain internal and we do not produce a document with the results to provide to the applicant. **TAMIU does not require foreign transcripts to be evaluated by a professional agency for graduate admission purposes.** Applicants who submit evaluation reports from a professional foreign credential evaluation agency are still required to submit all official transcripts and certificates of graduation (if applicable) to TAMIU's Graduate School as part of the applicant's admission requirements as these evaluations do not substitute official transcripts. The Graduate School reserves the right to accept or reject the results of evaluations completed through professional agencies in accordance with our standards and practices.

Applicants seeking to have their foreign transcript evaluated by a professional agency for personal/employment reasons are recommended to utilize the services of a professional agency that is a member of the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES) or the Association of International Credential Evaluators (AICE).
