Under the provisions of Texas Education Code, Section 51.931, you have the right to an "Academic Fresh Start". If you're a Texas resident and apply for admissions (or re-admission) to a Texas public college or university and enroll as an undergraduate, you may be able to begin a new course of study with a clear academic record. All academic work that was earned 10 or more years prior to the planned enrollment date can be ignored for enrollment purposes under this provision.

Please note: this is an "all or nothing" option. You cannot choose which courses to ignore and which courses to count. If you choose this provision, you will not receive any credit for any courses you took at least ten years ago. This means that these courses:

- -cannot be used to fulfill new pre-requisite requirements;
- -cannot be counted toward your new degree; and
- -will not be counted in your new GPA calculations.

They will, however, still show on your transcript, but will have a notation about their status.

Individuals who choose this provision must still meet current published admission criteria for TAMIU and must submit officials transcripts from all colleges attended.
