- II. Dr. Kohl charged the Committee with the Core Curriculum Review
- III. Samples of Core Curriculum Review. Materials relevant to Core Curriculum Review will be provided to the Committee members for their perusal. A UCC meeting to discuss Core Curriculum Review will be scheduled.
- IV. Changes to Catalogue, College of Science and Technology. The following were approved unanimously:
 - A. On pages 409-410 of the current catalog, delete MATH 5300 - Bridge Analysis I, MATH5301 - Bridge Analysis II, MATH 5302 - Bridge Linear Algebra, MATH 5303 - Bridge Abstract Algebra
 - B. Add, MATH 5304* - Number Theory I, MATH 5306 - Linear Algebra, MATH 5320 - Complex Variable I, MATH 5330 - Abstract Algebra I, MATH 5398 - Thesis I and MATH 5399 - Thesis II.
*Pending number clarification from Ms. Lunce to avoid confusion caused by using the same number. Number provided by Ms. Lunce.
- V. Dr. Cargill moved, Dr. Rudolph seconded the following motion which was passed unanimously:
All curriculum changes are subject to the approval of the revised core by the Regents and the Coordinating Board and do not take effect unless approved.
- VI. Changes to Catalogue, College of Science and Technology. The following were approved unanimously:
 - A. Add ENGL 4399 Senior Seminar - with prerequisite change to delete the reference to 100 or more college credits.
 - B. Add SPAN 4399 Senior Seminar - with prerequisite change to delete the reference to 100 or more college credits and with a number clarification from Ms. Lunce.
 - C. Renumber SPAN 4399 Spanish for Professional Purposes to SPAN 4390 Spanish for Professional Purposes.
 - D. The following were approved as degree program changes based on the proposed new core:
 1. BA Major in Communications: Core - **42 SCH**; **Math or** Social Behaviors Science Elective; Major - **42 SCH**; **General** Electives - **18 SCH**, at least **12 SCH** at the 3000-4000 level. Communications: 3 SCH from **SPCH 1311 or ENGL 2311**.
 2. BA Major in English: Core - **42 SCH**; **Math or** Social Behaviors Science Elective; Major - **48 SCH**; **General** Electives - **15 SCH**, at least **9 SCH** at the 3000-4000 level. Removed Communications: 3 SCH designated as

SPCH 1311.

3. BA Major in Spanish: Core - **42** SCH; **Math or** Social Behaviors Science Elective; Major - **45** SCH; **General** Electives - **12** SCH, at least **9** SCH at the 3000-4000 level. Removed Communications: 3 SCH designated as SPCH 1311.

E. The following were referred to the college for review of total hours required for the degree:

1. BA in English Language Arts and Reading with Certification for Grades 8th-12th
2. BS in English Language Arts and Reading with Certification for Grades 4th-8th
3. BA in Spanish with Certification for Grades 8th - 12th
