**1. MA 1342 Introductory Statistics - now required as second math (Changes are marked in red).**

**Justification: This is a necessary subject in order to take the research class and this is the only available option.**

**2. BIOL 2401 or 1470**

**2. Natural Science 3 SCH**

**Justification: Accreditation agency indicated that human biology and anatomy were required, but the accreditation agency stated that the human component can be fulfilled through psychology courses.**

3. **SOCW 3305 has been renamed to Border & Diversity Issues in Social Work to better reflect content of course (Change is previously approved by e-vote and does not need to be voted on but is listed to avoid confusion).**

4. **Advanced social work electives used to be nine hours and it will be reduced to six hours plus social work 405**

**NEW:**

4. **SOCW 4305 Writing for Professional Social Work has been added to address students' writing needs, to help them address eight content areas which are the focus of the program, and integrate these into a portfolio.**

**Justification:** Curriculum committee members were concerned that removing technical writing did not match the CORE requirements and in order to comply, communication is the first footnote and includes all three options on p. 418 of the current catalog core listing. This is now listed in footnote 1.

5. **Restricted Electives Footnote 5, page 126**

**NEW:**

5. **Footnote regarding Restricted Electives - one 3 hour course should be chosen from any upper division behavioral or social science; one 3 hour course is chosen from the list of psychology courses with the human element.**

**Justification:** Accreditation agency said that one course should contain content relevant to human development and specific courses were selected from psychology to meet the accreditation agency requirement for the human element.

**OLD:**

- 6, **Both ENGL 2311 and SPCH 1311 were requirements**

6. **Delete 3 hrs. from degree leaving it at 120 hours and give students option of ENGL 2311, HUM 2301 or SPCH 1311 as outlined in core curriculum. This now listed as the communication requirement as per core curriculum and is footnote 1 chronologically.**

**Justification:** Core curriculum only requires three hours in communication.

7. **Delete SOCW 3302 course description from catalog.**

**Explanation:** All changes have been made to comply with CSWE standards, writing requirements, core curriculum (p. 418 of catalog) and 120 hour requirement.

**Justification:** It was already deleted from the four year plan in previous years, but it was not removed from the course descriptions/. (This is a cosmetic change that may not require a vote.

**Old:**

Catalog has five footnotes which have been substantially changed, including eliminating the statement about the footnotes option because it's required.

**New:**

**7. All footnotes for the social work degree were renumbered chronologically. This necessitated placing communication as footnote 1; visual and performing arts as footnote 2; footnote 3 is the advanced social work electives and footnote 4 is the advanced restricted electives.**
