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COMM 4351 Methods of Teaching Communication. Three semester hours. (SP) This course is for instructors who are currently teaching or preparing to teach a class in human communication and communication studies. Primarily intended for secondary school teachers, this course will survey select methods to teach communication principles and skills. In particular, the course will focus on hands-training in how to: identify the essential elements of communication applications; develop a communication applications curriculum for their respective classroom [either 6-8 grade or 9-12 grade]; run a UIL/TFA tournament; know and understand the rules for tournament competition; and become familiar with how to incorporate communication applications coursework with TAKS & TEKS requirements. Prerequisite: Admission to teacher certification program or permission of department chair. Full major or minor status.
