This topic is integral to the field of sociology and provides students with greater definition of what their field of study will cover than a topics course, which varies. Because race is a social construct and not a biological reality, the terms racial-ethnic are paired in the new course title.
- (2) 4300-level courses are being removed from the <u>major and minor</u> to allow for a more advanced program of study to ensure that all student work will be at a graduate level of complexity and to provide for more intense interaction between graduate students and faculty. Thus, the statement that no more than six hours at the 4000 level can be taken should be deleted.
- (3) PADM has been added to the list of minors.
