Three semester hours. (FL/SP/SS)

Conducted in Spanish. **The second of two basic requirements for all SPAN 3000-4000 courses.**

This course will provide students with a general knowledge of the literature of the Spanish-speaking world, while assisting the development of critical and analytical skills. The genres of poetry, prose and drama will be represented. Prerequisite: SPAN 2320, or equivalent.
