This course may focus on selected author, historical periods, literary movements, genres, themes or cultural issues in Spanish American literature. Course may also cover any aspect of Spanish American Culture or Transatlantic approaches to Hispanic cultural production other than literature including but not limited to film, folklore, music, popular culture, visual culture, etc. in any time period. May be repeated when topic changes. Prerequisite: Either SPAN 4300, 4303, 4306, or 4309. May be taken for graduate credit.

Justification: This course is for the most advance students, with some characteristics of the directed study. For these reasons the prerequisite should be any course of the 4000 level. Graduate students should take only graduate courses.
