Conducted in Spanish. The study of two major genres of Spanish American literature, works of interest both to students of modern Spanish American culture and to those planning graduate work in Spanish. The topic will be determined each time the course is offered, mindful of needs of both students and faculty. Works studied will include: Poetry: Darío, Neruda, Vallejo, Borges Short story: Cortázar, Rulfo, García Márquez, Borges. May be repeated when topic changes. Prerequisite: **SPAN 3323 or 3326.**

Justification: It is a new course number which is in accordance with 4000 level courses. It is a new title for this course as well. SPAN 2320 has been deleted as prerequisite because it is a prerequisite to take SPAN 3323 and SPAN 3326.
