SPAN 4314 (formerly SPAN 3331) *Spanish Literature Before 1500*. Three semester hours. (SP/SS-Odd)

Conducted in Spanish. Will feature selected ~~authorial, generic or thematic studies of major texts from Spanish medieval literature~~ studies of the complete versions of major Spanish medieval texts including *El Cid*, *El Conde Lucanor*, *El libro de Buen Amor* and the *Celestina*. Prerequisite: Either SPAN 3321, 3322 or 3333.

Justification: It is a new course number which is in accordance with 4000 level courses. In order to avoid confusion it is better to have "formerly SPAN 3331" right after SPAN 4314. This description is more appropriate for the content of the course. At the level of prerequisite, students who have taken SPAN 3322 or 3333 are also prepared to take this course.
