Conducted in Spanish. Will ~~cover specific authors, genres or topics such as Golden Age Drama, Renaissance and Baroque poetry, the Romancero, la novella picaresca, the novellas ejemplares.~~ feature selected authorial, generic or thematic studies of the complete versions of major Spanish Golden Age texts, featuring the picaresque and exemplary novels, the Romancero, Baroque poetry, and the dramas of Lope de Vega, Tirso de Molina and Calderón de la Barca. Prerequisite: Either SPAN 3321, 3322 or 3333.

Justification: It is a new course number which is in accordance with 4000 level courses. In order to avoid confusion it is better to have “formerly SPAN 3332” right after SPAN 4315. This description is more appropriate for the content of the course. At the level of prerequisite, students who have taken SPAN 3322 or 3333 are also prepared to take this course.
