ARTS 4301

Advanced Drawing.

Three semester hours.

Beyond rendering, this class will address the interaction of drawing, materials, and conceptualization. In-class critiques, out-of-class assignments, and independent self-motivated projects are the largest components of this course. This class meets five hours a week. Prerequisites: ARTS 1316 and 1317. Course fee: \$40.00. **May be repeated once for credit.**

ARTS 4303

Advanced Painting.

Three semester hours.

Beyond rendering, this class will address the interaction of painting, materials, and conceptualization. In-class critiques, out-of-class assignments and independent self-motivated projects are the largest components of this course. This class meets five hours a week. Prerequisites: ARTS 2316 and 3308. Course fee: \$40.00. **May be repeated once for credit.**

ARTS 4304

Advanced Sculpture.

Three semester hours.

A continuation of Intermediate Sculpture, this course will address the interaction of sculpture, materials, and conceptualization. In-class critiques, out-of-class assignments, and independent self-motivated projects are the most important components of the course. Prerequisite: ARTS 3309. Course fee: \$40.00. **May be repeated once for credit.**

ARTS 4324

Advanced Ceramics.

Three semester hours.

A continuation of ARTS 3324, this course will address the interaction of ceramics, materials, and conceptualization. In-class critiques, out-of-class assignments, and independent self-motivated projects are the most important components of this course.

Prerequisite: ARTS 3324. Course fee: \$50.00. **May be repeated once for credit.**

ARTS 4365

Advanced Photography.

Three semester hours.

A continuation of ARTS 3365, this course will concentrate on the realization of content as creative expression and a heightened mastery of photographic skills in the darkroom and in the computer lab. Prerequisite: ARTS 3365. Course fee: \$40.00. **May be repeated once for credit.**

Justification: Students wishing to follow a discipline track at the advanced level need to be able to apply their elective credit hours to their chosen discipline. Taking the advanced level class for two semesters for credit allows them to pursue their self-motivated projects at a greater depth and over a longer period.
