GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

The School of Nursing adheres to all general requirements and procedures of the university for graduation. For deadlines and requirements, see TAMIU catalog. In their final year, students need to verify with their advisors that all requirements for graduation and/or honors have been met. In addition, students are eligible to apply for graduation when the following conditions are met:

- 1. completion of required semester credit hours
- 2. a cumulative GPA of 2.00
- 3. completion of all clinical studies coursework

ELIGIBLITY FOR GRADUATION IN BASIC NURSING

Satisfactory performance on diagnostic examinations designated by the School of Nursing to validate potential successful performance on the National Council Licensure Examination is required for basic students to be eligible for graduation.

- 1. All students in the final semester of the clinical nursing program will enroll in NURS 4190 4290: Senior Lab Seminar.
- 2. At the beginning of the final semester, students will be administered a diagnostic examination by the School of Nursing.
- 3. Upon receipt of the resulting diagnostic profile, each student will be counseled by the faculty advisor to identify areas of strength and weaknesses. The student and faculty will develop a contract for an individualized plan to assist in meeting the student's needs.
- 4. A comprehensive examination will be administered during the final semester. To be eligible to write the comprehensive examination, the student must provide evidence that the terms of the contract have been met.
- 5. Students who fail to demonstrate satisfactory performance on the comprehensive examination will not be eligible for graduation.
- 6. A student who does not achieve satisfactory performance on the comprehensive examination will be required to re-enroll in NURS 4190 4290: Senior Seminar and retake the exit examination at the end of the course. If satisfactory performance is not achieved on the second attempt at the course NURS 4190, 4290 the student will not be eligible for a degree.

Degree Requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing.

- 1. **Hours Required**: A minimum of **127** 120 semester credit hours (SCH): 45 hours must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements as specified in the <u>Requirements for Graduation</u> and the **Dr. F.M. Canseco School of Nursing** sections of this catalog.
- 2. **University Core Curriculum: 41** SCH as outlined in the suggested plans and as specified in the <u>Requirements for Graduation</u>. Wellness/Activity requirements met within nursing courses.
- 3. Social/Behavioral Science Elective: 3 SCH designated as PSYC 2301
- 4. **Other Education Requirements: 11** SCH including BIOL <u>2415</u>, CHEM <u>1406</u> and MATH 1342.
- **5.** Major: 72 SCH. The Canseco School of Nursing has developed a 120 SCH BSN curriculum plan that includes the modifications and redistribution of the existing curriculum. Overall program philosophy, conceptual framework and curriculum design remain the same. The changes result in a tighter curriculum with reduced repetition of content, particularly pharmacology and growth and development, and increased clinical clock hours, while reducing overall credit hours from 127 to 120.

- a. The 3 SCH course in growth and development dropped from prenursing requirements. The infant and adolescent component will be incorporated in Child Health Nursing and the adult and geriatric component will be incorporated in Adult Health I and II.
- b. The 3 SCH nursing pharmacology course will be dropped and the content incorporated into all clinical nursing courses. The Basic Nursing Skills course will be responsible for incorporating the initial introduction of medication calculations and this component will be addressed in every clinical course thereafter.
- c. The Basic Nursing Skills course will increase from 3 to 4 SCH to increase practice and clinical time for beginning students.
- d. The 6 SCH Maternal/Child Health Nursing course will be separated into two courses of 5 SCH each (2 lecture and 3 lab) to run concurrently over the entire semester to enhance mastery of content and access to clinical resources.
- e. The existing 4 SCH Leadership/Management course and 3 SCH Nursing Issues course to be combined in single 3 SCH Issues in Nursing Management course, to condense essential content.
- f. The Nursing Elective will be eliminated.
- g. The Community Health Nursing course will incorporate epidemiology content.

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- h. The International Health Nursing course will decrease from 4 SCH to 3 SCH.
- i. The Emergent Care Nursing course will increase from 4 to 5 SCH, to include required bioterrorism content.
- j. The Senior Lab Seminar will increase from 1 to 2 SCH, all lab hours at 3:1.

The overall impact of these curricular changes is as follows, on overall SCH, nursing SCH, and theory and clinical clock hours.

CORE: 41 SCH (+1 hour health/PE met in nursing courses)

OTHER: 11 SCH (science and math)

NURSING: 68 SCH (6 prenursing; 33 theory; 29 clinical/lab)

TOTAL: 120 SCH

Attached are two tables, the first comparing the 127 hour and 120 hour clinical nursing curricula on a semester-by-semester basis and the second outlining the complete 4 year 120 hour curriculum.
