- a. Each student will be required to complete one of three specialized internships. Plan A requires that the student complete 150 hours of supervised research or evaluation experience, which prepares the student for work as a social science researcher or entrance into a Ph.D program. Plan B requires that the student complete 150 hours of supervised fieldwork experience, which prepares students for placement in the business or social service community. Plan C requires that the student complete 150 hours of supervised teaching or research experience, which prepares students for a position in a school district or community college setting or for entrance into an educational psychology Ph.D. program.
- b. A four hour comprehensive examination will be administered after the student completes the required course work.
- c. The thesis course must be repeated until the thesis is completed.
- d. An oral thesis defense will be supervised by the student's Advisory Committee.
- e. All courses taken in pursuit of this program will only be valid for five years.
