Description:

This course is designed to provide experience in a symphonic Wind Ensemble literature while developing many aspects of musicianship. Students will be exposed to a wide range of literature. Several performances are presented every semester. Course Goals:

- To develop strong musicianship techniques.
- To perform at an exceptionally high, professional manner.
- To perform in front of various audiences.

Music / Text:

Music will be provided by the FPA Department.
