An introduction to the principles of music that can be related to the expressive and developmental needs of children from pre-school through the fourth grade. This course does meet the Visual and Performing Arts requirement in the University Core Curriculum for Early Childhood Education majors.

Justification:

- Required to bring Early Childhood Education degrees closer to the 120 hr. rule.
- Early Childhood education majors will take all three 1100 courses (MUSI 1100 / ARTS 1100 / DANC 1100) to satisfy requirements for Core Curriculum
- Provides a more rounded set of educational competencies for education majors in preparation for the TeXes / ExCET exams.
- Content is specifically education oriented and the courses will be restricted to education majors.
- COAS and COED have collaborated to make this agreement work to the benefit of the students while meeting the requirements of reduction of SCH in the degrees.

Student Learning Outcomes:

The student will understand, plan and execute music experiences designed for the young child. The student will explore the many areas of music that can be valuable to the overall development of the young child.

The student will be familiar with the following areas associated with music: Songs, Movement, Listening Skills, Musical Concepts and Rhythm.
