The Department of Curriculum & Instruction requests authority to **eliminate** the following courses from the degree plan for Bachelor of Science in Interdisciplinary Studies Major in Early Childhood Reading Specialization.

ARTS 3100 Art and Children, One semester hour. An introduction to the principles of art that can be related to the expressive and developmental needs of children from preschool through the fourth grade.

DANC 3100 Dance/Theatre and Children, One semester hour. An introduction to the principles of dance and theatre performance related to the expressive and developmental needs of children from preschool through the fourth grade.

MUSI 3100 Music and Children, One semester hour. An introduction to the principles of music that can be related to the expressive and developmental needs of children from preschool through the fourth grade.

The Department of Curriculum & Instruction requests authority to **add** the following courses in the degree plan for Bachelor of Science in Interdisciplinary Studies Major in Early Childhood Reading Specialization.

ARTS 1100, Art and Children, One semester hour. Required for the Visual/Performing Arts Core Curriculum Elective, to be offered only for students pursuing the BSIS in EC-4 with a specialization in Reading.

DANC 1100 Dance/ Theatre and Children, One semester hour, Required for the Visual/Performing Arts Core Curriculum Elective, to be offered only for students pursuing the BSIS in EC-4 with a specialization in Reading.

MUSI 1100 Music and Children, One semester hour, Required for the Visual/Performing Arts Core Curriculum Elective, to be offered only for students pursuing the BSIS in EC-4 with a specialization in Reading.

EDRD 3320 Content Reading. Three semester hours. This course focuses on content reading instruction in grades 4-12. Emphasis on reading strategies and study skills for reading specialized texts. Prerequisite: Admission to the College of Education and 2.7 overall grade point average.

Rationale for Courses:

ARTS 1100, DANC 1100, MUSI 1100. All students are currently required to choose a 3 credit hour elective in Visual/Performing Arts as part of their core curriculum. Those students pursuing a BSIS in EC-4 with a Bilingual specialization will be required to take these three one-hour courses in lieu of another elective in the Visual/Performing Arts area to fulfill their core curriculum requirement in this area.

EDRD 3320. The rationale for adding this course relates to the new EC-6 certification. It is critical that those individuals with EC-6 certification have additional preparation in teaching reading in the content areas.
