I was advising a student at the LCC Transfer Fair this morning who is > pursuing a BA in Art with all level certification and I noticed on the degree plan that Block I and Block II are split. Block I consists of EDCI 3301 and EDCI 3302, and on the degree plan EDCI 3301 is listed in the first semester of the junior year and EDCI 3302 is listed in the second semester of the junior year.
