Major: 51 45 SCH including ENGL 4355 ENGL 4399; Histories Surveys of Literature: 6 SCH (in addition to the survey of literature course taken as part of the Core Curriculum) selected from the following: ENGL 2322, 2323, 2327, 2328, 2332 or 2333; Language Studies: ENGL 3361, ENGL 3339 and either ENGL 3347 or 4309; Major Authors: ENGL 4301; American Literature: 3 SCH from ENGL 3303, 4332 or 4333; 3 SCH from ENGL 4323 or 4324; and 3 SCH from ENGL 3303, 3309, 3329, 4323, 4324, 4332, 4333, 4337, or 4398 (when topic is American); British Literature: 3 SCH from ENGL 4325, 4327 or 4328; 3 SCH from ENGL 4329, 4330, or 4331; and 3 SCH from ENGL 4306, 4325, 4327, 4328, 4329, 4330, 4331, 4336, or 4398 (when the topic is British); Advanced English Electives: 9 SCH from 3000-4000 level ENGL courses.
- Minor: A minimum of 18 SCH from one discipline at least twelve of which must be at the 3000-4000 level. See Appendix B.
