Degree Requirements for the BA with a Major in History

- 1. Hours Required:** A minimum of **120** semester credit hours (SCH): 45 hours must be advanced, and fulfillment of the degree requirements as specified in the “Requirements for Graduation” section of this catalog.
- 2. University Core Curriculum:** **42** SCH as outlined in the suggested plans and as specified in the “Requirements for Graduation”.
- 3. Math Elective:** **3** SCH selected from any math course above the level of College Algebra.
- 4. Social/Behavioral Science Elective:** **3** SCH selected from HIST 3350/3351.
- 5. Geography:** **3** SCH designated as GEOG 1303.
- 6. Major:** **39** SCH including HIST 2321, 2322, 3302, 4310; 12 SCH chosen from HIST [3301](#), [3320](#), [3330](#), [3342](#), [3392](#), [3393](#), [3394](#), [4302](#), [4320](#), [4330](#), [4340](#), or [4391](#); 9 SCH chosen from HIST [4316](#), [4317](#), [4318](#), [4366](#), [4367](#) or [4368](#); 6 SCH chosen from HIST [3370](#), [3380](#), [3385](#), [4364](#) or [4390](#).
- 7. Minor:** A minimum of **18** SCH from one discipline, at least 12 of which must be at the 3000-4000 level. See Appendix B.
- 8. General Electives:** **12** SCH at the 3000-4000 level.
