The Department of Curriculum & Instruction requests authority to **eliminate** the following courses from the degree plan for Bachelor of Science in Interdisciplinary Studies Major in Early Childhood Bilingual Specialization.

*EDEC 1308 Parenting Skills. Three semester credit hours.* An in-depth exploration of child-rearing practices and family systems. Examines all aspects of family life, including social, economic and personal problems confronting parents.

*SPAN 4313 Problems in Teaching Spanish ECE-4<sup>th</sup>. Three semester credit hours.* Conducted in Spanish. Study of the linguistic principles, methodological theories, and classroom techniques conducive to effective and efficient teaching of Spanish as a native or second language to children from pre-K through the 4<sup>th</sup> grades. Recommended for prospective teachers.

*ARTS 3100 Art and Children, One semester hour.* An introduction to the principles of art that can be related to the expressive and developmental needs of children from preschool through the fourth grade.

*DANC 3100 Dance/Theatre and Children, One semester hour.* An introduction to the principles of dance and theatre performance related to the expressive and developmental needs of children from preschool through the fourth grade.

*MUSI 3100 Music and Children, One semester hour.* An introduction to the principles of music that can be related to the expressive and developmental needs of children from preschool through the fourth grade.

The Department of Curriculum & Instruction requests authority to **add** the following courses in the degree plan for Bachelor of Science in Interdisciplinary Studies Major in Early Childhood Bilingual Specialization.

*ARTS 1100, Art and Children, One semester hour.* Required for the Visual/Performing Arts Core Curriculum Elective, to be offered only for students pursuing the BSIS in EC-4 with a specialization in Bilingual Education.

*DANC 1100 Dance/Theatre and Children, One semester hour,* Required for the Visual/Performing Arts Core Curriculum Elective, to be offered only for students pursuing the BSIS in EC-4 with a specialization in Bilingual Education.

*MUSI 1100 Music and Children, One semester hour,* Required for the Visual/Performing Arts Core Curriculum Elective, to be offered only for students pursuing the BSIS in EC-4 with a specialization in Bilingual Education.

**Rationale for Courses:**

*EDEC 1308, Parenting Skills:* The content of this course can be infused throughout the other Early Childhood coursework that the students are required to take for this degree. The content of this course is no longer directly addressed in the Texas teachers' certification standards for Early Childhood Education.

*SPAN 4313, Problems in the Teaching of Spanish ECE-4<sup>th</sup>.* The content of this course overlaps with the content provided in coursework in Bilingual Education, notably EDBE 3325, EDBE 4334 and EDBE 4336.

*ARTS 1100, DANC 1100, MUSI 1100.* All students are currently required to choose a 3 credit hour elective in Visual/Performing Arts as part of their core curriculum. Those students pursuing a BSIS in EC-4 with a Bilingual specialization will be required to take these three one-hour courses in lieu of another elective in the Visual/Performing Arts area to fulfill their core curriculum requirement in this area.
