ENGL 5365 *Seminar in Rhetoric. Teaching Internship in Rhetoric and Composition:* Three semester hours. (FL) This course will review and evaluate traditional, modern, and innovative theories of rhetoric and the teaching of composition. Participants will be asked to prepare sample syllabi for freshman composition courses and essay assignments and will learn to assess writing by young adults. This is primarily an internship course, so all masters candidates who will be teaching freshman composition must register for this course prior to taking a teaching assignment or concurrently. Registration concurrent with teaching assignment is preferred. Prerequisite: Graduate standing.

Rationale: The title needed to more accurately reflect the purpose of the course, especially now that we have teaching assistants who need an internship course.
