**COURSE PREFIX: MUSI** 

**NUMBER**: 2217

**TITLE**: Aural Training IV

**SCH VALUE**: Two semester hours.

**DESCRIPTION**: A continuation of MUSI 2216, this is a companion course to 2212. It is designed to further the understanding of chromatic and Twentieth Century harmony through related aural exercises, dictation and sight singing.

**PREREQUISITES**: Prerequisites: Completion of MUSI 2216 with a grade of "C" or better, completion of MUSI 2211 or consent of instructor, current enrollment in or completion of MUSI 2212.

## STUDENT LEARNING OUTCOMES:

Students who complete this course will successfully be able to:

- Aurally identify all diatonic triads and seventh chords, secondary dominants, and chromatic chords in major and minor keys in any inversion
- Accurately notate the bass and soprano lines and corresponding harmonies (any from the list above) in harmonic dictation
- Accurately notate diatonic and chromatic melodies (major and minor), modal melodies, and melodies using artificial scales in melodic dictation
- Accurately notate rhythms using borrowed rhythms, extreme subdivisions of the beat, and various 20<sup>th</sup> century techniques in rhythmic dictation
- Sight-sing chromatic and modulating melodies, modal melodies, and melodies using artificial scales and tone rows
- Demonstrate fluency in solfege syllables
- Aurally recognize formal units in sonata procedure

• Perform rhythmic exercises containing extreme subdivisions of the beat, borrowed rhythms, cross rhythms, and metric modulations
