The Department of Curriculum & Instruction requests authority to eliminate EDRD 3300 Word Identification from the degree plan for Bachelor of Science in Interdisciplinary Studies Major in Early Childhood Education Reading Specialization and add EDRD 3302 Teaching Reading to Bilingual/Multicultural Young Learners to the degree plan for Bachelor of Science in Interdisciplinary Studies Major in Early Childhood Education Reading Specialization.

*EDRD 3300 Word Identification. Three semester credit hours.*

This course prepares prospective reading teachers to develop students' word identification skills through the teaching of: (1) phonics; (2) structural analysis; and (3) context. A variety of instructional strategies are taught for developing children's abilities to use phonics, structural analysis, and context to aid in word identification and the development of fluency in reading. Prerequisite: Admission to the College of Education and 2.7 overall grade point average.

*EDRD 3302 Teaching Reading to Bilingual/Multicultural Young Learners. Three semester credit hours.*

Critical multicultural perspectives on the acquisition and development of reading by young children who represent bilingual multicultural backgrounds; critique of language development practices as applied in education settings with young children. Prerequisites: Admission to the College of Education and 2.7 overall grade point average.

**Rationale for Courses:** EDRD 3302 is to be added to the degree plan for Bachelor of Science in Interdisciplinary Studies Major in Early Childhood Education Reading Specialization. Given increasing numbers of English Language Learners, it is critical that students pursuing this degree have adequate preparation in teaching reading to bilingual, multicultural young children. At the same time, rather than increasing the total number of hours for the degree, it is necessary to eliminate a course. Much of the course content of EDRD 3300 is covered in EDRD 3309, EDRD 3303 and EDRD 3311. By eliminating EDRD 3300 and adding EDRD 3302, the degree is strengthened while maintaining the same number of hours.
