This is the same plan for the minor, but it amended to show that many of the GEOG courses are also URBS courses. Also, since we were specifying those crosslistings, it seemed necessary to specify all the crosslistings. Hence, you can see that this new minor intended to combine the Geography minor and the Urban Planning minor does, indeed contain URBS courses. Also, we feel it is necessary to keep, for the time being, all the URBS courses listed in the catalog for two reasons. 1) we do still have a few Urban Planning and Admin. minors under older catalogs. If necessary, we will teach some courses by IS for these "orphaned" minors.
