Rationale for degree changes:

- 1. The degree's media concentration was deleted because the video production courses are being combined into two courses instead of four. There is little demand for this concentration as we have had only 1 student in the past 4 years who had it formally designated on his transcript.
- 2. The other change is to remove at least 9 SCH from other COMM electives at the 3000-4000 level. This change is for simplifying the text since all but 1 course is in the 3000 to 4000 level. The degree has 5 required courses which are specifically listed in the degree plan and the rest are electives so the designation of "required" and "advanced" electives are not necessary.
- 3. Numbers COMM 3133, 3233, 3303 are being eliminated from the degree.
- 4. COMM 3326 has eliminated "course may be taken more than once when topics vary" because this does not match description, and the topic of the course is the same each time it is delivered.
- 5. COMM 3327 has eliminated "course may be taken more than once when topics vary" because the description has been changed to one topic for this course.
- 6. Six SCH have been removed from the Junior year, and six SCH have been moved from the Sophomore year to the Junior year to accommodate the new COAS requirement of a six-hour Foreign language requirement.

Certain courses (COMM <u>3132</u>, <u>3133</u>, <u>3232</u>, <u>3233</u>, <u>3324</u>, <u>3326</u>, <u>3327</u>, <u>3331</u>, and <u>4330</u>) may be taken more than once (when topics vary) for credit within the degree program. Note: A Concentration in Media Production will be earned if 15 SCH of the work done for the major are taken from COMM <u>2331</u>, <u>3302</u>, <u>3303</u>, <u>3324</u>, <u>3327</u>, <u>3331</u>, <u>3332</u>, <u>3333</u>, and <u>4330</u> (if subject is media production). Students desiring a Concentration in Media Production noted on their transcript must request it on their Application for Graduation.

Degree Requirements for the BA with a Major in Communication

- 1. **Hours Required:** A minimum of **120** semester credit hours (SCH): 45 hours must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation" section of this catalog.
- University Core Curriculum: 42 SCH as outlined in the suggested plans and as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation".
- 3. MATH Elective: 3 SCH selected from any math course above the level of College Algebra.
- 4. Communication: 3 SCH Select from ENGL 2311 or SPCH 1311 [part of the University Core Curriculum].
- 5. Major: 42 39 SCH including: COMM 3300, 3310, 4340, 4350, 4360 and 27 24 SCH selected from remaining COMM courses with at least 3 SCH from COMM 2331, 3102/3202, 3132, 3133, 3202, 3232/3132, 3233, 3303, 3327, 3331, or 4330 (if the topic has a media focus) and at least 9 SCH from other electives at the 3000-4000 level. COMM 4325 may be replaced with MGT 3320. Certain courses (COMM 3132, 3133, 3232, 3233, 3324, 3326, 3327, 3331, and 4330) may be taken more than once (when topics vary) for credit within the degree program.
- Concentration in Media Production (optional): Will be earned if 15 SCH of the work done for the major (see #5) are taken from COMM 2331, 3302, 3303, 3324, 3327, 3331, 3332, 3333 or 4330 (if subject is media production). Students desiring a Concentration in Media Production noted on their transcript must request it on their Application for Graduation.
- 7. **Minor: A minimum of 18 SCH from one discipline** at least twelve of which must be at the 3000-4000 level. See <u>Appendix C</u>.
- 8. Foreign Language: 6 SCH in one language.
- 9. General Electives: 15 12 SCH, at least 9 6 SCH of which must be at the 3000-4000 level.
