## Degree Requirements for the BA with a Major in English

**Hours Required:** A minimum of **120** semester credit hours (SCH): 45 hours must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements as specified in the “[Requirements for Graduation](#)” section of this catalog.

1. **University Core Curriculum: 42** SCH as outlined in the suggested plans and as specified in the “[Requirements for Graduation](#)”.
2. **MATH Elective: 3** SCH selected from any math course above the level of College Algebra.
3. **Major: 45-39** SCH including ENGL [4399](#); **Surveys of Literature: 6-3** SCH (in addition to the survey of literature course taken as part of the Core Curriculum) selected from the following ENGL [2322](#), [2323](#), [2327](#), [2328](#), [2332](#) or [2333](#); **Language Studies:** ENGL [3339](#) and either ENGL [3347](#) or [4309](#); **Major Authors:** ENGL [4301](#); **American Literature:** 3 SCH from ENGL [3303](#), [4332](#) or [4333](#); 3 SCH from ENGL [4323](#) or [4324](#); and 3 SCH from ENGL [3303](#), [3329](#), [4323](#), [4324](#), [4332](#), [4333](#), or [4398](#) (when topic is American); **British Literature:** 3 SCH from ENGL [4325](#), [4327](#) or [4328](#); 3 SCH from ENGL [4329](#), [4330](#), or [4331](#); and 3 SCH from ENGL [4306](#), [4325](#), [4327](#), [4328](#), [4329](#), [4330](#), [4331](#), [4336](#), or [4398](#) (when the topic is British); **Advanced English Electives: 9-6** SCH from 3000-4000 level ENGL courses.
4. **Minor: A minimum of 18 SCH from one discipline** at least twelve of which must be at the 3000-4000 level. See [Appendix C](#).
5. **General Electives: 12** SCH, at least six of which must be at the 3000-4000 level.
6. **Foreign Language: 6 SCH beyond the 2-unit requirement for entrance to the university.**
7. **BA/MA Option:** See Combined BA/MA Programs in this section.
