- 1. **University Core Curriculum: 42** SCH as outlined in the suggested plans and as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation".
- 2. **MATH Elective: 3** SCH selected from any math course above the level of College Algebra.
- 3. **Major:** 45 39 SCH including ENGL 4399; Surveys of Literature: 6 3 SCH (in addition to the survey of literature course taken as part of the Core Curriculum) selected from the following ENGL 2322, 2323, 2327, 2328, 2332 or 2333; **Language Studies:** ENGL 3339 and either ENGL 3347 or 4309; **Major Authors:** ENGL 4301; **American Literature:** 3 SCH from ENGL 3303, 4332 or 4333; 3 SCH from ENGL 4323 or 4324; and 3 SCH from ENGL 3303, 3329, 4323, 4324, 4332, 4333, or 4398 (when topic is American); **British Literature:** 3 SCH from ENGL 4325, 4327 or 4328; 3 SCH from ENGL 4329, 4330, or 4331; and 3 SCH from ENGL 4306, 4325, 4327, 4328, 4329, 4330, 4331, 4336, or 4398 (when the topic is British); **Advanced English Electives:** 9-6 SCH from 3000-4000 level ENGL courses.
- 4. **Minor: A minimum of 18 SCH from one discipline** at least twelve of which must be at the 3000-4000 level. See <u>Appendix C</u>.
- 5. **General Electives: 12** SCH, at least six of which must be at the 3000-4000 level.
- 6. Foreign Language: 6 SCH beyond the 2-unit requirement for entrance to the university.
