Justification: EDCI 3305 Middle/Secondary School Methods, Management and Discipline replaced the old EDCI 3304 Methods, Management, and Discipline for all Arts and Sciences degrees when the old ExCET Elementary Comprehensive K-6 certification exam was replaced by the TExES Generalist EC-4 certification exam. The EDCI 3304 course was renamed Methods, Management and Discipline for the Early Grades. Now the TExES Generalist EC-4 exam is being replaced with the TExES Generalist EC-6 exam, so we can return to the original EDCI 3304 Methods, Management, and Discipline course with no grade level designation. For the past several years Arts and Sciences majors needed to take EDCI 3305 Saturday mornings, which is a hardship for several students who want to leave Laredo on weekends to visit their families. With this change, Arts and Sciences majors will have a choice of four sections of the EDCI 3304 course offered on different days, including Saturday mornings. This will make the scheduling of classes much easier for students.
