- 2. An incorrect superscript exists at the end of the current listing of "Visual/Performing Arts" in the sophomore year, spring semester. It should be a "2" and not a "1." Along with the change in title (#1 above), it should ultimately be reworded as: "Visual, Literary and Performing Arts²".
- 3. The text for the footnote for the Visual, Literary and Performing Arts (core) requirement (this is footnote #2 below).

¹When enrolled in applied music lessons, students must be concurrently enrolled in both an assigned University ensemble and MUAP 1010.

²3 SCH of any courses listed in Appendix A will satisfy the Visual, Literary and Performing Arts required in the Core Curriculum for instrumentalists. Voice majors must take MUSI 1161, 1162 and 2161.

³Communication, select 3 SCH from HUM 2301 or COMM 1311.

⁴Math elective, select 3 SCH from any math course above the level of College Algebra. Recommend MATH <u>1342</u>.

⁵Music Education Curriculum, select 4 SCH from MUSI <u>3266</u>, <u>3268</u>, <u>3283</u>, <u>3288</u>, <u>3289</u>. 2 SCH must be in the major area of musical concentration.

⁶Advanced Music Theory elective, select 3 SCH from MUSI <u>3346</u> or <u>3347</u>.

⁷Music Education Curriculum, select 2 SCH from MUSI <u>3227</u>, <u>4257</u>, <u>4258</u>, <u>4259</u>.

This will also affect the Program of Study, slightly, as follows (in #2 below):

Degree Requirements for the Bachelor of Music with All-Level Certification

- 1. **Hours Required:** A minimum of **133** semester credit hours (SCH): 45 hours must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation" section of this catalog.
- 2. **University Core Curriculum: 42** SCH as outlined in the suggested plans and as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation". 3 SCH of any courses listed in Appendix A will satisfy the Visual, Literary and Performing Arts required in the Core Curriculum for instrumentalists. Voice majors must take MUSI 1161, 1162 and 2161.
- 3. MATH Elective: 3 SCH selected from any math course above the level of College Algebra.
- 4. **Major:** 64 SCH of MUAP, MUEN, and MUSI as follows: 16 SCH of MUAP with at least 8 SCH upper division in primary instrument, and MUAP 4005. 31 SCH of MUSI to include MUSI 1181, 1182, 1211, 1212, 1216, 1217, 1302, 2181, 2211, 2216, 3253, 3254, 3300, 3301, and 3 SCH selected from MUSI 3346 and 3347. 9 SCH of MUEN Performance Music Ensemble is required to include 7 SCH in ensemble associated with the primary instrument and 2 SCH of upper division credits in a secondary ensemble. 8 SCH of MUSI to include MUSI 3233; 4 SCH from MUSI 3266, 3268, 3283, 3288, or 3289 including 2 SCH in the major area of musical concentration; and 2 SCH selected from MUSI 3227, 4257, 4258 or 4259. When enrolled in applied music lessons, students must be concurrently enrolled in both an assigned University ensemble and MUAP 1010.
- 5. Professional Development: 21 SCH including: EDCI 3301, 3302, 3304, 4993 and EDDP 4324.
- 6. Support Area: 3 SCH of EDRD 3320.
- 7. **Other requirements:** Must pass the piano proficiency exam, and must audition with a full-time faculty of the major performance area. Must complete a minimum of 6 semesters (with at least 8 SCH at the 3000-4000 level) in the same principle area.
- 8. **Music Elective: 6** SCH of 3000-4000 level MUAP, MUEN or MUSI with approval of music studies advisor.
- 9. **Other requirements:** Must audition with full-time faculty of the music performance area. Must complete 6 semesters in the same principal area.

Justification:

The proposed changes to the Visual, Literary and Performing Arts (core) requirement vastly increases instrumental music majors' course options to any MUSI, MUED, or MUEN courses. Previously, all instrumentalists were limited to one course, but after review, it has been concluded that being able to choose from a wider variety of music courses will better fit students' individual needs.
