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HUM 4137-4473 Undergraduate Research. One to four semester credit hours.

A course adapted to the directed, interdisciplinary study of topics in the liberal arts. Advanced students will develop a project in cooperation with a designated instructor chosen by the student. The nature of the material may allow for the involvement of multiple instructors. The project will be established by the student with the approval of the designated instructor prior to registration. The course may be repeated with a change in project, but total credit cannot exceed eight semester hours. Prerequisite: Permission of the designated instructor.

- Students will be able to categorize relevant research material through the preparation of an annotated bibliography
- Students will be able to hypothesize about a relevant topic through the composition of essays
- Students will be able to report the results of their investigations through the completion of a research paper
