Justification: This new course will be the third in a series of 8 courses students can enroll in when participating in the college publications (print and online) of the TAMIU student newspaper, THE BRIDGE. The series of courses will allow students to gain college credit for their contributions to the school newspaper- i.e., writer, photographer, editor, graphic designer, marketing personnel, and advertising director- and to enroll in the higher-level courses when continued participation is desired (News Publications IV, V, VI, VII and VIII).
