**Justification:** This revision is designed to follow the new guidelines for majors as suggested by the Dean of the College of Arts and Sciences. The BA in History has been streamlined and cut to allow students more flexibility. This new plan has also streamlined the organization of upper-division offerings in history to better reflect the capacity of the current faculty to offer courses in the major.

## Degree Requirements for the BA with a Major in History

- 1. **Hours Required:** A minimum of **120** semester credit hours (SCH): 45 hours must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements as specified in the "<u>Requirements for Graduation</u>" section of this catalog.
- 2. University Core Curriculum: 42 SCH as outlined in the suggested plans and as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation."
- 3. MATH Elective: 3 SCH selected from any math course above the level of College Algebra.
- 4. Social/Behavioral Science Elective: 3 SCH selected from HIST <u>3350/3351</u>.
- 5. Foreign Language: 6 SCH in one language.
- History Major: 33 SCH including HIST 2321, 2322, 3302, 3303, 4310; Non-US HIST, select 9 SCH chosen from HIST 3301, 3320, 3330, 3342, 3392, 3393, 3394, 4302, 4320, 4330, 4340, or 4391; U.S. History, select 9 SCH chosen from HIST 3370, 3380, 3385, 4316, 4317, 4318, 4366, 4367, 4368, 4364, or 4390.
- 7. Geography: 3 SCH designated as GEOG <u>1303</u>.
- 8. **Minor: A minimum of 18 SCH from one discipline** at least twelve of which must be at the 3000-4000 level. See <u>Appendix C</u>.
- 9. General Electives: 12 SCH, at least 9 of which must be at the 3000-4000 level.
- 10. BA/MA Option: See Combined BA/MA Programs in this section.
