**PADM 5383 Nonprofit Law and Process (3 SCH)**

This course covers nonprofit law in the United States for nonprofit organizations. It includes the legal steps to form a nonprofit organization, reporting requirements, boards of directors' responsibilities, audit requirements and other legal obligations for nonprofit organizations. Prerequisite: graduate standing in the Master of Public Administration program at TAMIU or graduation from a master's degree program from any accredited university.
