Good Morning,

I am applying the updates to the BSN and RN BSN programs to the online catalog and came across an issue.

The TAMUS System requires all undergraduate programs to have a minimum of 6 SCH of Math. The updates to the programs indicate that students have an option of taking MATH 1342 or PSYC 2317 (not 2327). To comply with System requirements, the course needs to be MATH 1342.

If you send me an email to make the change, I will add it as a note to the UCC document.

Degree Requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (RN/BSN).

1. Hours Required: A minimum of **120** semester credit hours (SCH): 45 hours must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements as specified in the “Requirements for Graduation” and the **Dr. F. M. Canseco School of Nursing** sections of this catalog.

2. University Core Curriculum: **42** SCH as outlined in the suggested plans and as specified in the “Requirements for Graduation”.

3. Other Education Requirements: **41** SCH including BIOL 2415 or 2421, MATH 1342 and 34 SCH credit by transfer.

4. Major: **37** SCH to include NURN 3302, 3315, 3405, 3414, 3590, 4263, 4299, 4340, 4522, and 4670
