COMM 5303 Qualitative Research Methods in Communication

Course description

This course introduces the humanistic approaches to communication research. It will examine the fundamental epistemologies, design, methods, and data analysis in communication research. The goal is for students to learn and apply course concepts by analyzing texts and conducting research projects.

Learning outcomes

- 1. Students will analyze and compare the philosophical underpinnings that inform qualitative research.
- 2. Students will analyze the rationale for selecting a humanistic approach within the communication discipline.
- 3. Students will examine and apply multiple qualitative methodological strategies for collecting, analyzing, and interpreting data.
- 4. Students will design a research project employing qualitative methods.

Course purpose

The purpose of this course is to introduce the humanistic approach to communication research and reinforce and apply course concepts in order for students to conduct independent research projects. This course will be a requirement for program completion.

Prerequisites: Graduate standing

Class format:

The class will be a combination of lecture, discussion, and in class activities. Students will read, analyze, and discuss academic journal articles as well other texts. Students will be required to

design a qualitative methods research project in the form of a written paper and oral presentation. The objective is for students to produce high quality academic work that can be submitted to academic conferences or academic journals.
