## Justification:

Request to change/update the following on the program of requirements and 4-year degree plan for the Bachelor of Music with Level Certification reflecting:

- 1. Changes to the 2014 CORE requirements
- 2. Changes approved Fall of 2013 to reduce the SCH of Aural Training (MUSI 1116, 1117 and 2116) and instrumental classes (MUSI 3127, 3133, 3115, 3166, 3188, 3189)
- 3. Add a lower level elective for music: Instrumentalists take MUSI 1302; Vocalists take MUSI 1161, 1162, 2161
- 4. Revision of the Music classes footnotes.
- 5. Eliminate the requirement for an additional upper level ensemble.

#### Degree Requirements for the Bachelor of Music with All-Level Certification

- 1. **Hours Required:** A minimum of **133** semester credit hours (SCH): 45 hours must be advanced, and fulfillment of degree requirements as specified in the "<u>Requirements for Graduation</u>" section of this catalog.
- 2. **University Core Curriculum: 42** SCH as outlined in the suggested plans and as specified in the "Requirements for Graduation". Any course listed in Appendix A will satisfy the Visual/Literary/Performing Creative Arts required in the Core Curriculum for instrumentalists. Voice majors must take MUSI 1161, 1162 and 2161.
- 3. **MATH Elective: 3** SCH selected from any math course above the level of College Algebra.
- 4. Life and Physical Science Lab: 1 SCH compatible with Life and Physical Science course.
- 5. Major: 55 SCH of MUAP, MUEN, and MUSI as follows: 16 SCH of MUAP with at least 8 SCH upper division in primary instrument, and MUAP 4005. \$ 7 SCH of MUEN Performance Ensemble associated with instrument; including 7 6 SCH in ensemble associated with instrument and 1 SCH additional upper division level ensemble. 35 SCH of MUSI to include: MUSI 1181, 1182, 2181, 1211, 1212, 2211, 1116, 1117, 2116, 3253, 3254, 3300, 3301; 3 SCH selected from MUSI 1302 (for instrumentalists) or (for vocalists) MUSI 1161, 1162, 2161; 3 SCH selected from MUSI 3346 and 3347; MUSI 3133; MUSI 3183; 3 SCH selected from MUSI 3127, 3135, 3166, 3168, 3188, 3189, which must not be in concentration with associated major instrument; 2 SCH selected from 4257, 4258, 4259, which should be in concentration associated with major instrument. When enrolled in applied music lessons, students must be concurrently enrolled in both an assigned University ensemble and MUAP 1010/3010.
- Music Elective: 3 SCH selected from MUSI 1302 for instrumentalists, or MUSI 1161, 1162 and 2161 for vocalists.
- 7. **COE Professional Core** 26 SCH including: EDCI 1102, 2210, 3224, 3301, 3302, 3315, <del>3304, 4993, 4310, 4693 and EDSE 4350</del>
- 8. Support Area: 3 SCH of EDRD 3320.
- 9. **Other requirements:** Must pass the piano proficiency exam, and must audition with a full-time faculty of the major performance area. Must complete a minimum of 6 semesters (with at least 8 SCH at the 3000-4000 level) in the same principle area.
