This course examines the trajectory of British literature from the outbreak of World War II to today, including the end of the British Empire and the increased expansion and diversification of the literary canon. Authors studied may include Durrell, Beckett, the Amises, John Osborn, Lessing, Achebe, Dylan Thomas, Larkin, Ishiguru, McEwan, and Zadie Smith. Course may be repeated when topic changes.

1. identify works of poetry and prose, fiction and non-fiction, and drama, that are generally understood to be representative of British literature from about 1940 to the present;
2. analyze the cultural, social, and historical aspects of these various works;

5. compose texts that effectively address purpose, style, and content. (This includes: clear focus, structurally unified development of ideas, appropriate rhetorical style and visual style, correct use of Standard American Academic English [SAAE], and appropriate and ethical use of primary and secondary sources.)
