Increasing the curriculum from 48 to 60 hours in the Masters of Arts in Counseling Psychology Program

# RATIONALE

The State of Texas Licensing Board for Professional Counselors requires that all graduates who take the Licensed Professional Counselor exam starting in August of 2017 must graduate from a Master's Degree program that requires 60hrs. Previously the Licensing Board required 48 hours. They will require 60 by the time our 2014 entrants graduate. If they do not graduate with 60 hours completed in the program they will not be permitted to take the LPC exam.
