Justification: State-mandated changes for COE, plus need to adjust degree to COE's new "Professional Core," while maintaining pre-2014 Core Curriculum for freshmen who entered this academic year. (A separate proposal incorporating the post-2013-14 Core Curriculum is also being submitted.) Furthermore, because COE now requires successful completion of the Core Curriculum as a college admission requirement, the sequence of courses in the old degree plan had to be changed around somewhat.
