

LEARNING OUTCOMES

By the end of the semester, students will be able to:

1. Identify on a globe the countries featured during the semester and be able to discuss orally or in writing the chief geographic and climatic features of the country;
2. Identify orally or in writing the dominate or official language(s), religions, and political and social institutions of a featured country;
3. Identify orally or in writing the unique cultural practices of a featured country;
4. Describe the complexities of a featured global problem and the challenges facing world leaders in ameliorating or eliminating the problem; and,
5. Describe in depth and analyze one feature of one country or one aspect of one global issue in a thoroughly researched, properly documented, and effectively written research report.
