- 4 *Transfer of Graduate-level Study:* Six hours of graduate level study with a minimum grade of 3.0 ("B") on a 4.0 scale may be transferred, with the consent of the Department Chair, from other accredited institutions of higher education.

## **Proposed:**

3. Transfer of Graduate-level Study: A maximum of six (6) semester hours with a minimum grade of 3.0 ("B") on a 4.0 scale can be transferred into a master's program with the consent of the Department Chair. In the A.R. Sanchez, Jr. School of Business, transfer credit may apply solely to elective/concentration courses; required courses that are part of the business graduate curriculum must be completed in residence.
