**BA 6199 Dissertation Research (1 semester credit hour)**

This course will prepare Ph.D. students to write and defend a dissertation in the field of international business and specialty areas through completing a research project appropriate for a doctoral graduate. Students must maintain continuous enrollment after passing comprehensive examinations and admission to candidacy.

The prerequisite for the course is the successful completion of all components of the Ph.D. Comprehensive Examination, approval from the PhD Director and to be scheduled to teach a class in the summer term. The course is graded pass/fail.

The instructor of record is the Dissertation Chair.

Learning Outcomes:

- 1) Shows evidence of understanding advanced international business concepts.
- 2) Shows knowledge of the literature and methodology in the student's advanced specialty field.
- 3) Show evidence of the ability to communicate research findings.


