EDAM 5319 Administration of School Facilities, Finance and Technology
 This course deals with systematic planning of school facilities including school finance and technology and its applications to curricular outcomes. Finance will include theory and practices of business management, basic accounting, internal accounting procedures and Texas public school finance. Additionally, theory and understanding of how to build a budget for a school campus is included. This course includes expectations for technology use; technology-rich school improvement processes; technology integration among faculty and staff; utilization of technology to assess, analyze and interpret student performance data to design, assess and modify students' instruction. Prerequisites: EDAM [5301](#), EDAM [5320](#), EDAM [5322](#) and EDGR [5320](#). Pre or co-requisites: EDAM [5305](#), EDAM [5321](#).

Student Learning Outcomes

1. apply various types of information (e.g., demographic data, campus climate, student achievement data, technology applications, and emerging issues affecting education) to develop a campus vision,
2. analyze instructional needs and allocate human and financial resources effectively and equitably,


