- Math Elective:** **3** SCH selected from any math course above the level of College Algebra.
- Life & Physical Science Lab:** **1** SCH compatible with Life & Physical Science course.
- Major:** **45** SCH including: KINE 1101, 1103, 1104, 1111, 1152, 2224, 2225, 2300, 2301, ~~2303~~, 2316, 3300, 3301, 3302, ~~3303~~, 3305, 3310, 4300, 4301, 4305, and 4307.
- Professional Education Core:** **26** SCH including: EDCI 1102, EDCI 2210, EDCI 3224, EDCI 3301, EDCI 3302, EDCI 3315, EDCI 4310, EDCI 4693 and EDSE 4350.
- Support Area:** **3** SCH selected from EDRD 3309 or EDRD 3320.



