Senior Seminar

Three semester hours.

The senior seminar is a special topics capstone course required of all English and English Language Arts majors. Course readings, class discussions, and papers will focus on a highly defined issue in the study of literature or language. All senior seminars, however, will require that students develop and demonstrate command of the research process and superior writing skills. Attention will also be paid to professional post-collegiate issues of relevance to English majors. Prerequisite: At least 21 semester credit hours in English

Revised Description:

ENGL 4399: Senior Seminar--WIN

Three semester hours. (FA) WIN designated.

The senior seminar is a special topics capstone course required of all English and English Language Arts majors. Course readings, class discussions, and papers will focus on a highly defined issue in the study of literature or language. All senior seminars, however, will require that students develop and demonstrate command of the research process and superior writing skills. Attention will also be paid to professional post-collegiate issues of relevance to English majors. **To earn credit for this course, students must earn a grade of “C” or better.** Prerequisite: At least 21 semester credit hours in English.

Justification: Senior seminars and/or capstones are WIN-designated courses, and students need to have this clearly identified in the catalog. Additionally, this course is offered on in the fall, and because of its WIN-designation, there is a grade minimum of “C” needed to earn credit for the course.
