Other topics include metabolism, acid-base balance, development, and heredity. Must be taken concurrently with BIOL 2102. Carries no credit for biology majors.
~~Prerequisite: BIOL 2301.~~

Justification: Removing prerequisite because BIOL 2301/2101 and BIOL 2302/2102 cover different material (not a continuation) and it is not necessary for students to know information from BIOL 2301/2101 for BIOL 2302/2102. This will also give students additional flexibility in scheduling the courses.


