Prerequisite: none.

SLOs: Upon successful completion of this course, it is expected that each student will be able to:

- 1. Appraise a particular contemporary geographic issue, analyze its components, concepts, and key actors, and then formulate potential outcomes and solutions to that issue.
- 2. Explain the breadth of a specific sub-field in geography.
- 3. Apply geographic concepts to contemporary world issues.
