

TAMIU Unmanned Aircraft Systems (UAS) /Drone Operation Program

Procedure Statement and Reason for Program

This program supplies instructions for the use of UAS on Texas A&M International University (TAMIU) property and the use of UAS off campus by a TAMIU representative.

Program

1. On TAMIU Property

- 1.1. TAMIU is located within class D air space and heavily regulated by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). To comply with FAA regulations, TAMIU has established a UAS flight operation program.
- 1.2. Requests for UAS operation.
 - 1.2.1.Please refer to EH&S for additional procedures that need to be followed per_System Regulation 24.01.07.
 - 1.2.2.Minimally, the following form will need to be completed, submitted and approved before flights can commence. <u>flight authorization form</u>
 - Upon receipt of the request by the EH&S office, the form will be evaluated, a letter of approval will be provided to the requesting party as appropriate.
 - The requesting party will need to have this letter of approval in their possession when they are operating the UAS/drone.
 - A copy of the letter of approval will also be supplied to TAMIU PD. Only the times and locations indicated on the letter of approval will be allowed for UAS operation.

- 2. Instructions for UAS use on other than Texas A&M International University (TAMIU) Property.
 - 2.1. Planning to fly a UAS off campus as a representative of TAMIU for research, training or any other reason that involves your status as a paid employee of TAMIU.

You will need to follow System Regulation 24.01.07.

- You will also be required to fill out the necessary <u>flight authorization form</u> and any other applicable paperwork/information and submit to EH&S.
- 2.2. If you are flying a UAS on your own time as a hobby/recreational user you should always follow the rules and regulations as dictated by the FAA. Know before you fly.
